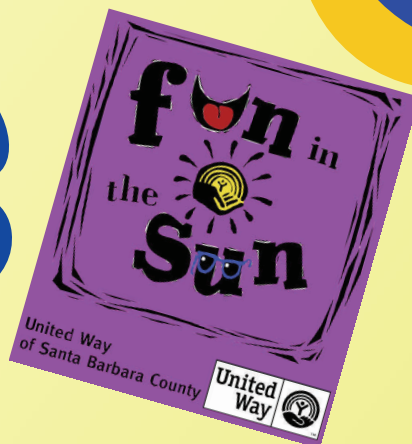


FACTS



Our Local Children

- ◆ 3000+ SB County children are homeless
- ◆ 1,000 are chronically homeless
- ◆ 81%+ of poverty-level children are Hispanic/Latino
- ◆ 100% of youth enrolled in public school receive Free & Reduced Lunch
- ◆ Below proficiency in standardized language & math tests—only 24% perform at or above 3rd grade reading average
- ◆ Fun in the Sun parents work 2.2 jobs on average
- ◆ Poverty-level children lose an average of 3 months of learning over the summer school break



Why Fun in the Sun?

- ◆ Offers a safe and nurturing summer enrichment program for homeless and low-income children
- ◆ Unifies the best elements of non-profits, education, business, government, and community volunteer resources
- ◆ Improves academic performance and social behaviors
- ◆ Provides healthy options for youth, which includes nutritious snacks and meals and daily exercise.
