<b>Goal 1</b> <b>General program participants will maintain or improve upon reading competence and positive perceptions of reading.</b>	<b>Target #1</b> – 60% of participants will display gains in reading comprehension, phonics, and vocabulary skills.	<b>Achieved</b> <b>(Comprehension: 77%)</b> <b>(Vocabulary: 73 %)</b>
	<b>Target #2</b> – 80% of participants will maintain or display a gain in positive perceptions of reading.	<b>Achieved</b> <b>(90%)</b>
<b>Goal 2</b> <b>General program participants will maintain or improve their positive identity and positive self-control.</b>	<b>Target #3</b> – 80% of participants will maintain or display a gain in positive identity (i.e., self-concept and esteem, and positive view of personal future).	<b>Achieved</b> <b>(95%)</b>
	<b>Target #4</b> – 80% of participants will maintain or display a gain in positive self-control (i.e., thinking carefully before acting, engagement in positive behaviors, and disengagement in negative behaviors).	<b>Achieved</b> <b>(99%)</b>
<b>Goal 3</b> <b>General program participants will maintain or improve perceptions of family support.</b>	<b>Target #5</b> - 80% of participants will maintain or display a gain in their perceptions of caring and support from parents/caregivers.	<b>Achieved</b> <b>(100%)</b>
<b>Goal 4</b> <b>General program participants will maintain or improve perceptions of community support.</b>	<b>Target #6</b> –80% of participants will maintain or display a gain in their ability to identify caring, supportive, non-parental adults.	<b>Achieved</b> <b>(100%)</b>

FITS-SOS Performance Measures	2010
1. A minimum of 70% of participants will have improved their ability to talk with, listen to, and understand others as they work to identify and address community problems.	89%
2. A minimum of 80% of participants will “agree/strongly agree” that they see themselves as a “strong resource that can make a difference in the community.”	98%

- As a result of their participation in FITS-SOS:
  - 90% of SOS students have a better understanding of how what they learn can be used in school and in everyday life.
  - 89% of SOS students improved their ability to talk with, listen to and get along with others.
  - 76% of SOS students plan to volunteer more in their community during the school year and in the summer.
  - 67% of SOS students indicated they would like to participate in SOS next summer.
- Average hours of service learning per participant= **106 hours**
- **\$63,500** in college scholarships were awarded to qualified (incoming 6<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> graders who completed 100 or more hours of service-learning during the 7 week period of FITS) FITS-SOS participants.
